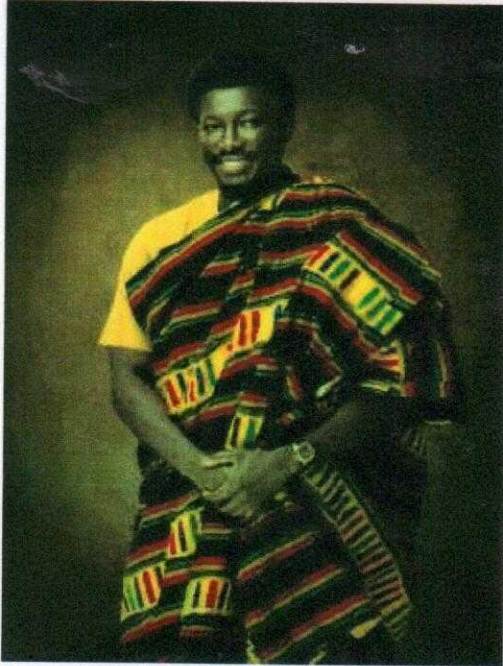

From selling clothes from the boot of his car in London to envisioning a 2,000-acre industrial city in Ghana, Nana Kwame Bediako's career is a testament to relentless ambition and a profound belief in African potential. But his impact is not measured in concrete and steel alone. Through his New Africa Foundation, Bediako has channeled his success into high-impact philanthropy, from funding life-saving surgeries for conjoined twins to providing disaster relief both at home and abroad.

In 2024, he took his most daring step yet, unveiling himself as the face behind the mysterious "New Force" political movement and running for President of Ghana. As one of the youngest candidates in the nation's history, his campaign electrified the political landscape, securing a third-place finish and establishing him as a powerful new voice for a generation demanding change.
